At Camp Jorn, we believe every child should have the opportunity to experience camp — regardless of financial circumstances. Scholarships and fundraising options are available to help families of all sizes and income levels.



Please note that all financial assistance applications are handled confidentially.

TO APPLY, FAMILIES MUST

1. Submit an online [Scholarship Application](#) along with a \$50 refundable deposit per camper
 - (Deposit is applied toward the camper's balance; refundable if canceled at least 4 weeks before camp.)

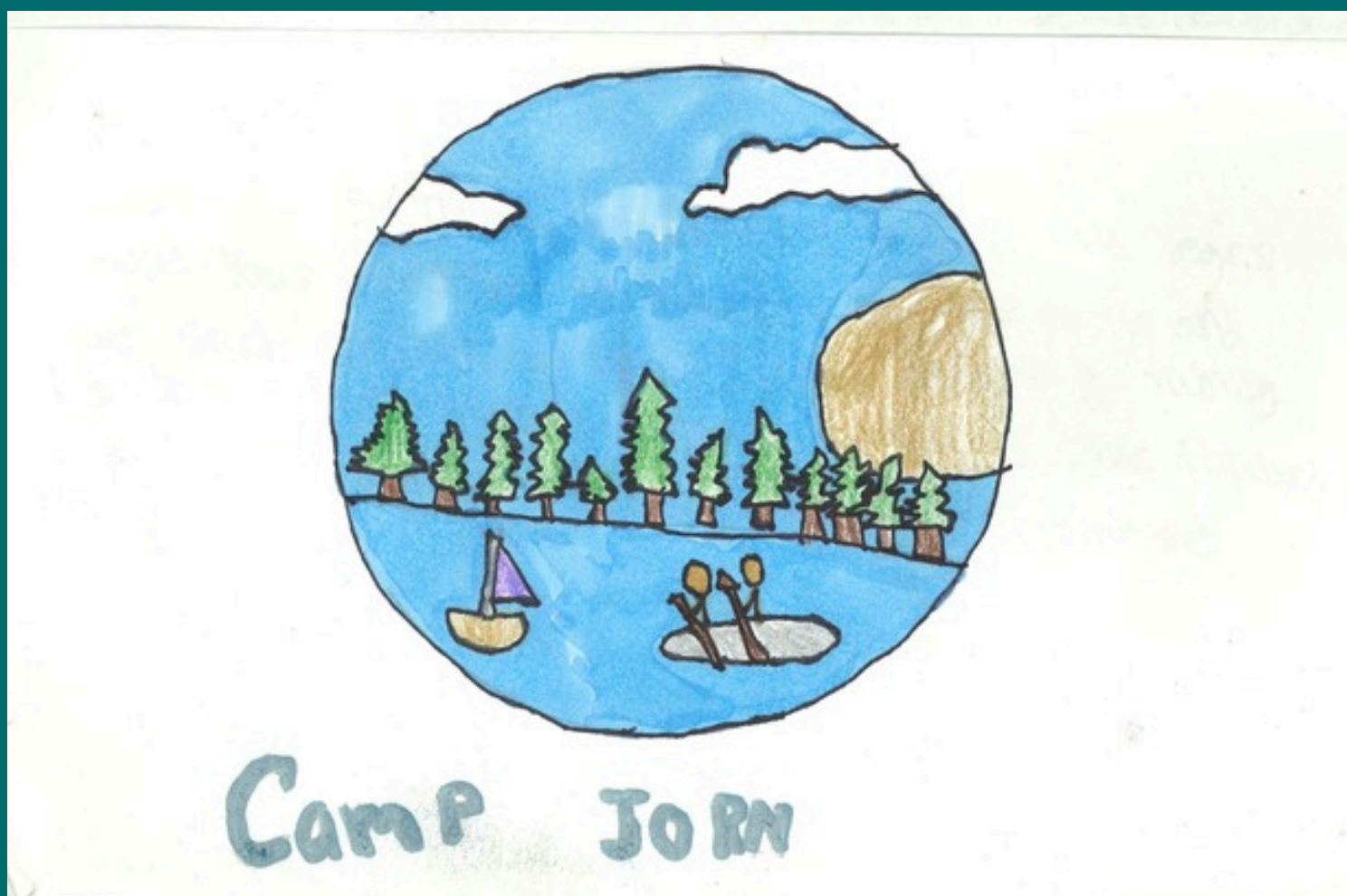


- 2. Provide proof of income, which may include (one of the following)**
- **A copy of your 2025 Federal Tax Form – first two pages of Form 1040 or 1040A**
 - **(Self-employed individuals must also include Schedule C)**
 - **A copy of your Medicaid card (front and back)**
 - **Two recent pay stubs for each parent/guardian in the household**
 - **A copy of your Free or Reduced Lunch Letter (if applicable)**



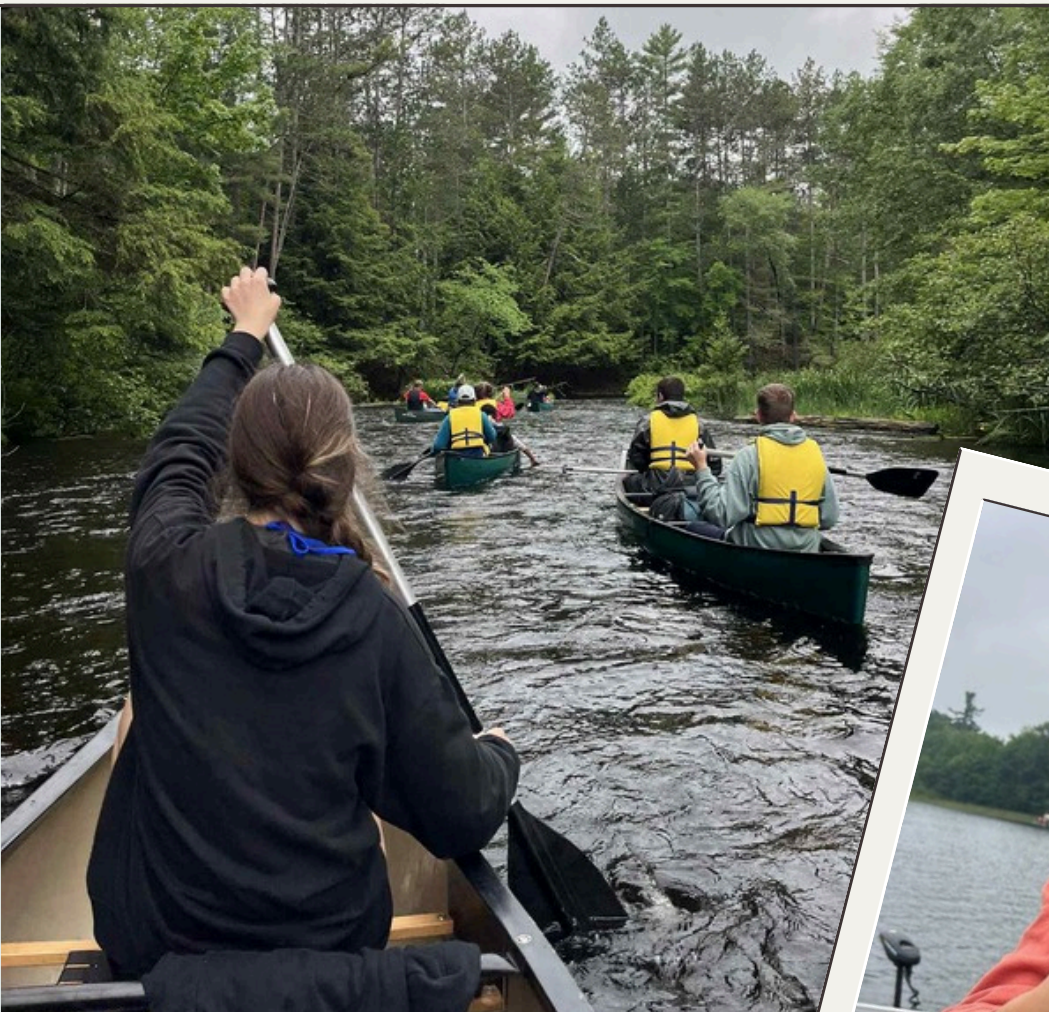
Typical Awards: Resident Camp families may qualify for up to 50% off the base rate, with a limited number of full scholarships available for those who qualify. Families attending Family Camp, Day Camp, or Sprouts may be eligible for up to 30% off the base rate.

Dear Donor,

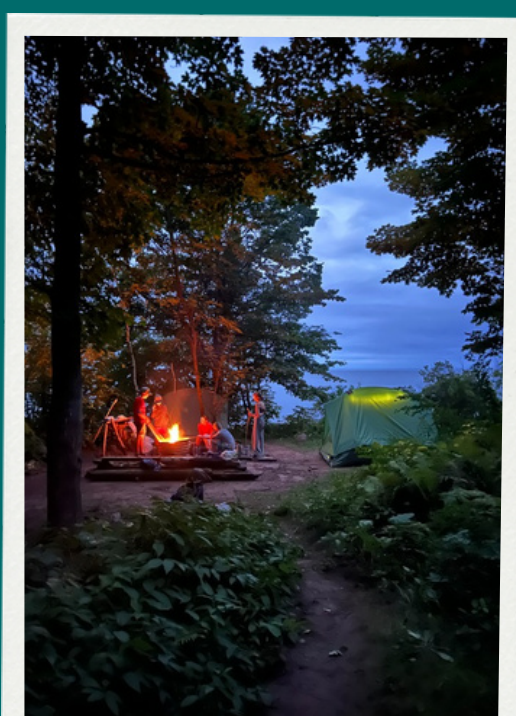
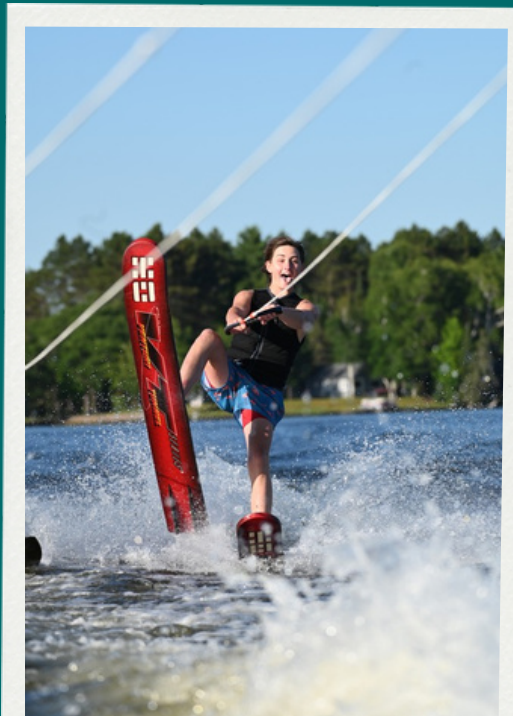
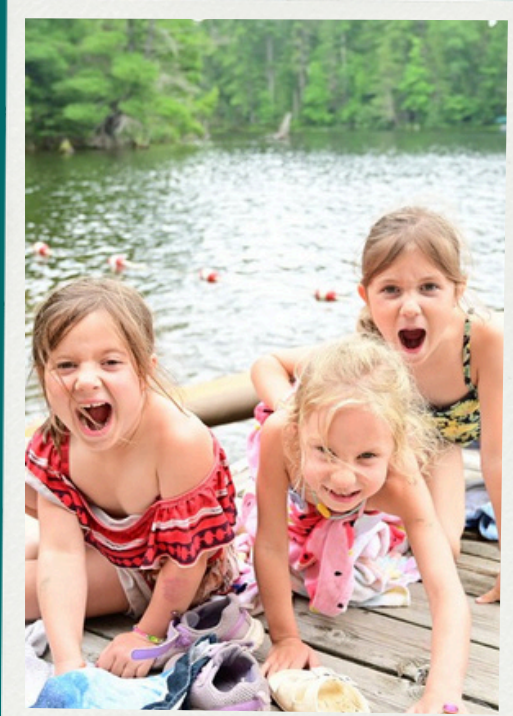
